POLICY:

It is the policy of The Care Center at Sunset Lake to ensure optimal infection control during a pandemic.

PROCEDURE:

As of May 12,2023 all active screening and testing requirements to enter the facility have been stopped. At this time we ask that all visitors self screen and remind all visitors and staff that if you have any signs or symptoms of COIVD -19 or other illness that you should not visit the facility.

If you are currently positive for COIVD -19 you are not permitted to visit the facility, if you have been exposed to COVID 19 in the past 10 days you should not visit the facility.

At this time we continue to require a paper surgical masks to be worn in the facility by all visitors and staff when in any area of the facility.

This policy does NOT apply to ombudsman or EMS workers. It also does NOT apply to compassionate caregivers that are visiting end of life patients (please get this approved by Nursing Supervisor, DON or Administrator prior).

If you see a visitor who appears to be ill, or someone is stating they were exposed please advise them that they should not continue with their visit today and that they should return when feeling well, this is for the safety of our staff residents and other visitors.
