Date: January 8, 2014

Commissioners Ann Prusinski & Rodney Gaebel are unable to attend the meeting scheduled for Thursday, January 9th as they have a prior engagement.

Despite the widely held perception that the Board of Elections is virtually idle at this time of year we can assure you that we remain quite busy as we gear up for village elections in March.

In the meantime we are:

- Commissioners have been meeting with County Attorney's office regarding the court case of Cohecton voters and also attended the hearing.
- Verifying, processing and filing the backlog of 1,200 new registrations that could not be entered until the 2013 General Election results had been certified.
- Cancelling voters weekly due to death, felony convictions, moves out of County or at the voters request.
- Organizing and documenting those records that can be destroyed after December 2013. This is a vital function in order for us to vacate the space required to retain used and unused ballots for a period of 2 years in accordance with NYS Election Law.
- Providing voters with records needed for passports, social services and veteran's benefits as well as pistol permits.
- We have been preparing the NYSBOE annual survey.
