IN SULLIVAN COUNTY RSVP Is ...?

5 volunteers between the ages of 55-59 29 volunteers between the ages of 60-64 115 volunteers between the ages of 65-74 113 volunteers between the ages of 75-84 43 volunteers that are over 85 years old

And our eldest volunteer Marie Zalesky is...104 years old!

228 female volunteers and 77 male volunteers.

60+ non- profit sites that our RSVP volunteers serve in.

Volunteers that served **54,000** hot meals to the homeless.

45 volunteer medical drivers, with over 3,459 hours, they travelled over 66,000 miles.

There were 1962 requests for medical transportation. The RSVP Department in collaboration with the Sullivan County Transportation Department provided close to 1,304 trips to the elderly of Sullivan County.

34 volunteers providing a much needed service at our local hospitals offering 6550 hours of service.

Our senior volunteers served **596** elderly, assisted in delivering **67,717** homebound meals. They also served **14,997** congregate meals to **396** clients.

20 volunteer tutors with over **1,516** hours that serve at the Literacy program were instrumental in teaching many Sullivan County adults to read, opening doors to a new future for them.

The AARP driver instructor volunteers held driver safety programs throughout Sullivan County and 1,293 people have completed the course.

That **3500** elderly seniors benefitted from friendly visiting, listening to piano music at nursing homes and hospitals. Many of our homebound elderly were the recipients of our telephone reassurance program and continue to boast of long-lasting friendships.

There are currently 305 active volunteers who served over 60,272 hours in 2011 @ \$22.50 per hour (per Corporation for National & Community Services) the value of their hours of service to Sullivan County is \$1,356,120.00!
