V. <u>Corporate Park Property</u>

Eisenberg reported that she had a 6-month check in call with Keller Williams on marketing the property. They reported that Westage is still interested but is concerned about making the numbers work with grading and utility costs. They inquired about any other possible tenants to share the space with, or further subdividing the property. The board was in agreement that further subdivision would not be in the best interest, and will send Westage a list of potential grant sources to fund the project. Eisenberg also reported that Keller Williams will be updating their listings and showcasing drone footage of the site recently taken by the County.

Eisenberg shared that the site plan review application is at the Town of Thompson building department, and that we are awaiting instruction from them on next steps. She also reported that she reached out to Verizon multiple times and has yet to receive a response on the possibility of a cell tower at the park property. Konefal shared that Verizon is having a meeting next week to approve the placement of the tower in Rock Hill.

VI. <u>Water Company</u>

Eisenberg reported the water company agreement is being reviewed by Richard Stoloff. He is conducting research to ensure everything is done properly as it is a public authority, and wanted to add a clause that would have the Town ensure that there will always be water for corporate park property tenants.

VII. Apollo Phase II

Eisenberg reported that New York State issues their grant determinations mid-December, and a positive result is anticipated. Next steps will be taken once funding is confirmed.

VIII. <u>ABO Meetings</u>

Johnstone reported that the Audit and Governance Committees would be meeting after the board meeting finished to comply with the twice yearly meeting requirement.
