- Riverfest was successful on many fronts. Excellent programming; multiple vendors expressed satisfaction with the day; attendee numbers looked good. Lack of wifi access and ATM raised as a concern; poster auction underperformed financially.
 Riverfest debrief will be done by programming and fundraising committees.
- **Staffing** shortages continue. More applicants responded to new recruitment efforts but only 2–3 appropriate. Follow up will be done with appropriate applicants.
- **Big Eddy** planning continues. Pre-festival event "Writers on Film changed venues to The Blue Fox
- **Tusten Theater** r/t the Big Eddy and the use of the Tusten Theater in general are the safety concerns secondary to the rise of the Delta variant. There was a robust discussion summarized as follows. Dan Hust will contact the Sullivan County Public Health Director for recommendations; Ariel Shanberg will draft protocols for



admission; the use of portable filter units will be evaluated. The goal is to safely use the Tusten Theater for the Big Eddy and other programming.
