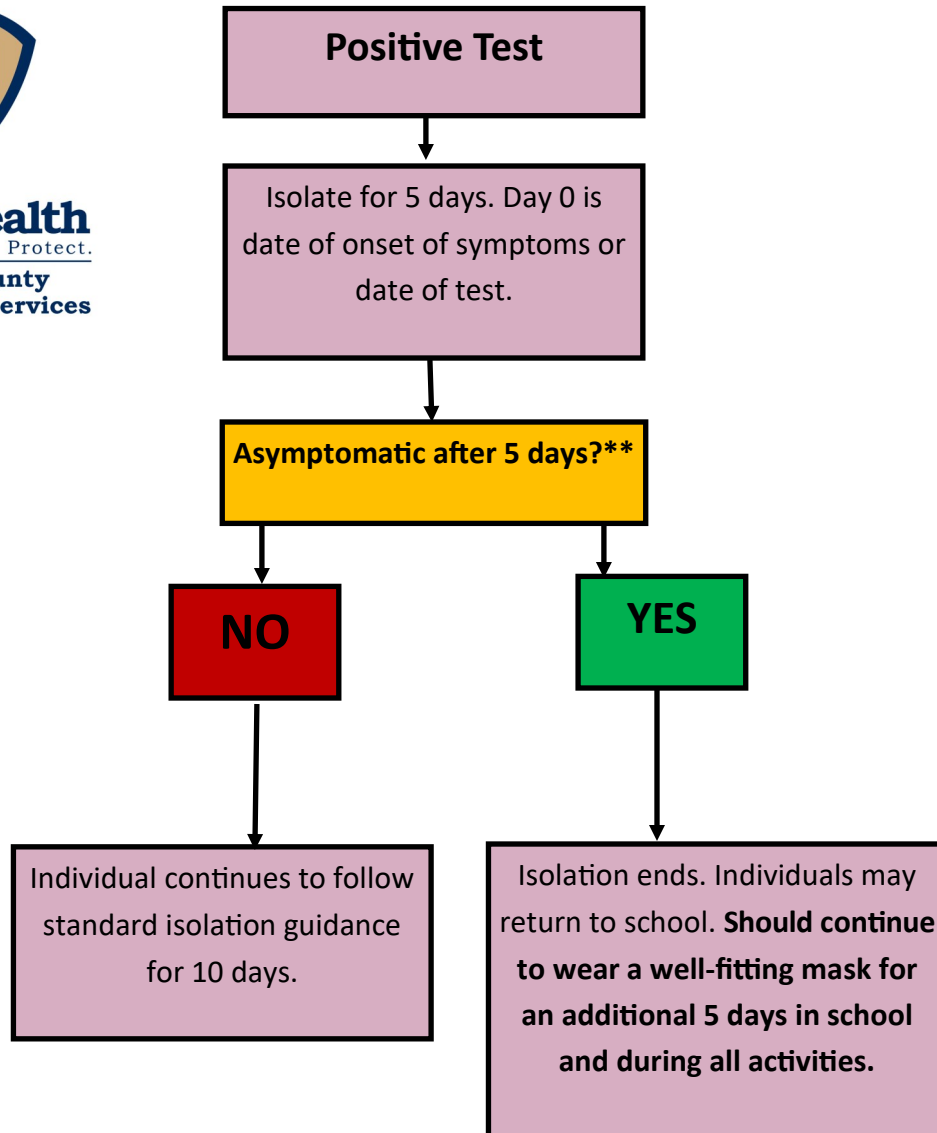


## School Guidance for a Positive COVID-19 Test

**\*\*Asymptomatic must include fever free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.**

**Isolation:** separates sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick.

**Quarantine:** separates and restricts the movement of people who were exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick.

# Guidance for Schools for a COVID Exposure

Isolate and seek testing. If a positive test, follow positive test guidance.

Classroom Activities and Bus Transportation

Extracurricular and After School Activities\*\*\*

All those fully vaccinated\*\* may continue to work at or attend school, regardless of booster status while wearing a well-fitting mask.  
**THIS ONLY APPLIES TO CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES AND BUS TO AND FROM SCHOOL.**

12 or Older and Eligible\*\*\*\* for a booster?

If you are eligible for a booster dose, but have not yet received it, you must adhere to the 5 day quarantine outside of classroom activities or bus transportation to and from school.

Those who have received a booster, or not yet eligible for a booster including children 5-11 who are not eligible for a booster, are considered fully vaccinated. They have no restrictions.

May **NOT** participate in extracurricular or after school activities\*\*\* and must adhere to the 5 day quarantine outside of classroom activities and bus transportation to and from school.

Effective 1/12/2022, subject to updates

\*\*Fully Vaccinated: At least 2 weeks after receiving either 2 doses of Moderna or Pfizer, or the single dose J&J / Janssen vaccine.

\*\*\* After school activities includes Boys and Girls Club Programming, or other latchkey programs.

\*\*\*\* Persons 12 and older are eligible for a booster when at least 5 months have passed since completing the primary vaccine series (2 doses of Moderna or Pfizer or 1 dose of J&J/Janssen).
