DESCRIPTION: The Office of Fire Prevention and Control (OFPC) is accredited by the National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications (commonly known as “The Pro Board”) to certify individuals who have met the requirements of the professional qualification standards established by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA).

National certification serves as validation that an individual’s training, knowledge and skills meet nationally recognized standards and, by doing so, improve both the application of standardized qualification levels and the recognition and acceptance of training across jurisdictional boundaries.

PREREQUISITES: This National Certification examination is available to students who can provide proof of completion of one or mor of the following courses of training/education.

- NYS Firefighter 1 course*.
- National Certification Registration form (*completed in full with qualifying signature*)

*Completion of the following NYS courses are accepted as equivalent with the Firefighter 1 course for prerequisite purposes: (1) NYS Firefighting Essentials or Basic Firefighter Training Course; (2) Initial Fire Attack or Intermediate Firefighter Course AND (3) NYS HMFRO course

REQUIREMENTS: A completed National Certification Examination Application must be uploaded onto the registration portal. To obtain this application, you can download it from the registration course page.
