Key Responsibilities:

Patient Care: Assist veterinarians in routine and emergency medical procedures, including surgeries, dental cleanings, and diagnostic testing. Caring for hospital patients; including but not limited to intravenous catheter placement and fluid maintenance, medication administration, tube feeding, fluid drain maintenance, central line placement and maintenance. Advanced skills are not required, we are looking for individuals to train, who are willing to learn. Medical Records: Maintain accurate and up-to-date patient records, ensuring all information is complete and accessible. Client Communication: Educate and communicate with pet owners regarding treatment plans, medication administration, and post-operative care.

Laboratory and Diagnostic Testing: Perform and interpret various lab tests, such as blood work, blood pressures, glucose monitoring, ECG/Holter monitor placement/management, urinalysis, focal ultrasounds (including cystocentesis) and radiographs.
