- Resolution (June 2014) all contracts more than \$50,000 become public

#### **ED** Report

- Eat Smart NY RFP has changed the whole application process
  - o SBN will be applying
  - o 60% of staff across the state will be losing their jobs because they do not meet the new qualifications

- OC will be the Regional Lead and will be hiring the staff that will work in Sullivan County
- Application was kicked back for additional information
- This means Sullivan County will have no staff to do nutritional programming. The staff will only be able to work with Food Stamp Eligible people
- Pat met with Freda and Melinda to discuss how the partnership is going and what is going to happen moving forward.

  - o Give more impact power point, visual
- Grants are seeking other funding opportunities
  - o Farmland Protection \$1,000,000 with County
  - Two block grants

  - o Elder Care with Office for the Aging possible funding CCE doing education
  - United Way Grant three year grant
  - o Financial Literacy SBN Grant
  - Community Foundation
