General discussion of cause-related marketing and Patagonia request for 2014-15: Up to \$12,000 (Sean knows Yvonne Chouinard) though Patagonia does not typically fund land protection. Nicole

suggests partnering with Cornell Cooperative Extension.

There's a need for evident connection of eagles to human habitat; Conservancy member property holding nests and ideal habitat.

General discussion to make \$150,000 work as seed money towards more funding (matching from foundations & individuals)

Possible press release to public about search for appropriate properties to protect.
